Physical Education

In P.E. we have lots of exciting games to play. We learn to jump, climb, stretch and balance and we sometimes do this on the apparatus or we might dance about or get the parachute out!

We use all the parts of our body when we do P.E.

When we get ready for P.E. we put on our special P.E. clothes. We wear our Beresford shorts and t-shirt.

This is our Foundation Stage outdoor learning and play area.

Food and Drink

In the morning, we have milk and a piece of fruit to make us big and strong.
