



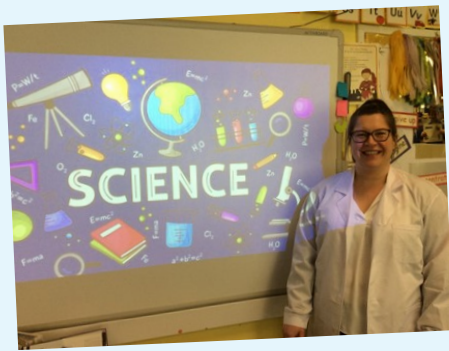
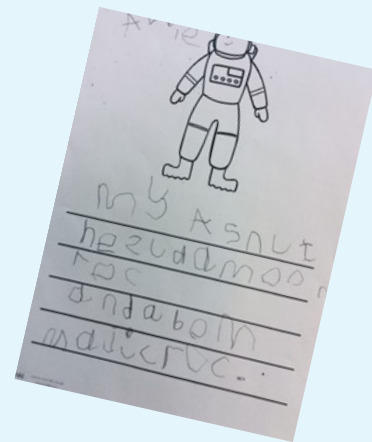
At Beresford, we celebrated British Science Week by Smashing Stereotypes. We learnt about different people who worked in Scientific job roles.

Nursery learnt all about Dr Ranj who is a doctor and a C Beebies presenter.



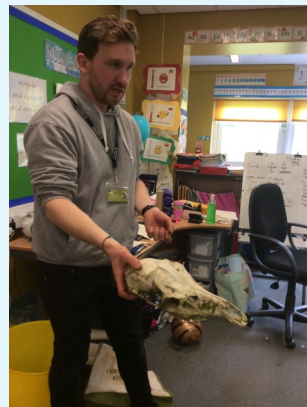
Year One had a visit from Katie Johnson from ThermoFisher Scientific. She taught us all about good and bad bacteria. We learned how to wash our hands well.
