- School finishes at 3.15 pm. You will be able to tell your grown up all about your busy day!



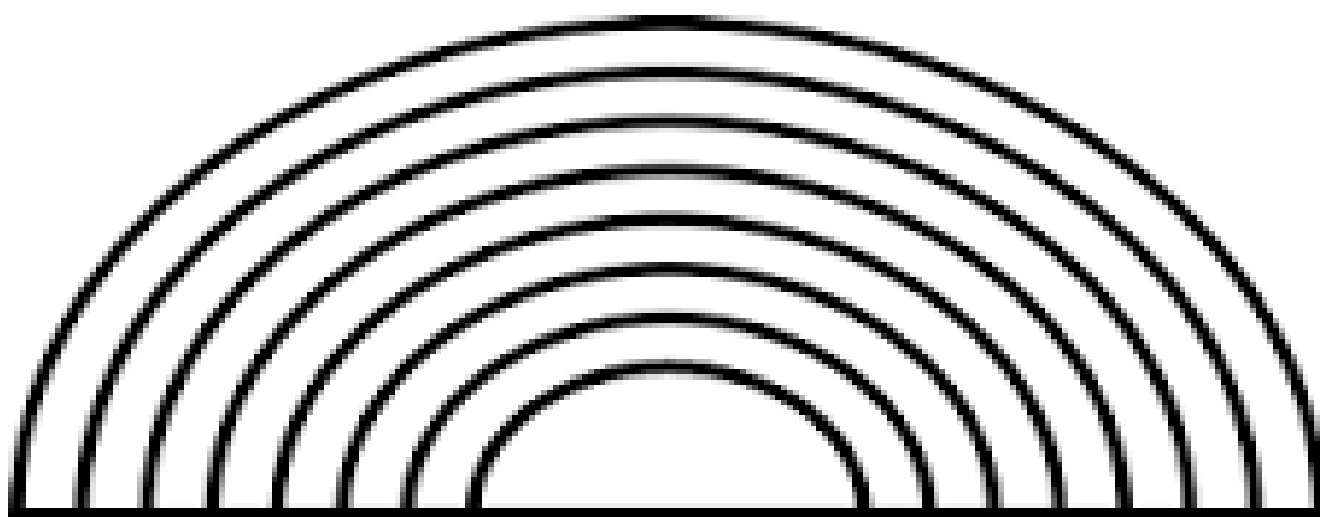
At School, we love to take part in PE lessons.

Can you fasten your coat?

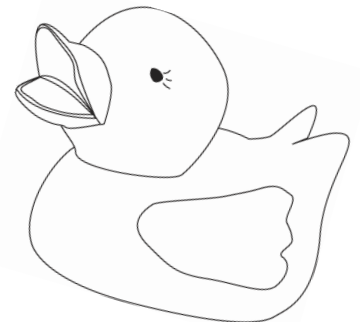
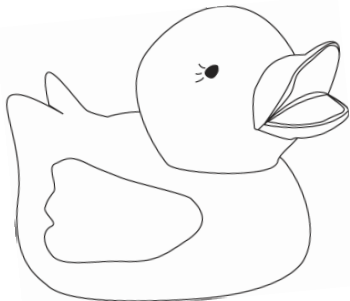
